The Department of Public Policy is recruiting multiple faculties with strong records in research and education in the following areas. Applications are invited for:

Duties: Contribute to research, service, teaching and teaching-related activities at both undergraduate and postgraduate levels. The appointees are also expected to be active researchers and contribute to the broader intellectual project of the Department in terms of publications, seminars, workshops and research proposals.

Requirements:

For post (1), a PhD in Public Administration or related disciplines with ability to teach general public management courses (such as Principles of Public Sector Management, Research Methods in Public Administration, and Public Organization Management), with research specializations in one or more sub-fields of public management [such as comparative public management, human resource management, or information and technology management (big data management)]. Candidates who can research and teach in public budgeting and finance are welcome to apply.

For post (2), a PhD in Public Policy or related disciplines with ability to teach general public policy courses (such as Introduction to Policy Making and Analysis, Evidence-based Policy and Practice, and Introduction to Urban Policies and Studies), with research specializations in one or more policy sub-fields (such as urban policy, transportation policy, social policy, healthcare policy, technology policy, or environmental policy). Candidates who can research and teach in housing policy and studies are welcome to apply.

For post (3), a PhD in Political Sciences or related disciplines with ability to teach general politics courses (such as Political Theories or Political Philosophy), with research specialization in one or more sub-fields (such as political analysis, Chinese politics, political ethics, Chinese/comparative philosophy, or political theories). Candidates who can offer general education courses (GE courses) in critical thinking, ethics and politics, and bioethics are welcome to apply.

For all posts, candidates are expected to have an active research agenda that leads to external funding, provide evidence of teaching ability (including student evaluations) and proven ability to produce high quality publications. Candidates for Associate Professor should have a substantial record of research publications, and are expected to take a leadership role in the Department's flagship public management programs for post (1), urban policy programs for post (2), and politics programs for post (3).
