## Welcome to the International Graduate Conference on “Philosophical Traditions: Comparative Philosophy and its Limits” Shanghai, November 9-11



It is our pleasure to invite **graduate students interested in comparative and global philosophy** to attend the international graduate conference on “**Philosophical Traditions: Comparative Philosophy and its Limits**”.

The conference, which has been organized by the International Division of the Graduate Student Union, Department of Philosophy, East China Normal University, and the Shanghai Association of Comparative Study on Chinese-Western Philosophy and Culture, will take place in Shanghai from **the 9th to the 11th of November, 2018**.



This conference aims to address the question of shifting paradigms in comparative philosophy and to create a dialogue concerning the current philosophical canon, questioning its exclusion of other global traditions, its ability to relate to all cultural contexts, and the utility of doing comparative philosophy.

It is hoped that the discussion concerning global alternatives to Western-focused philosophy will be broadened by introducing and presenting philosophical traditions and philosophers that have been underrepresented throughout the history of philosophy. The growing importance of Chinese philosophy within the humanities, for example, provides a good point of reference for challenging the current position of “Western” philosophy and the relation it has with other intellectual traditions.

Some well-known professors of comparative philosophy, hopefully including Prof. Yang Guorong and Van Norden, will be invited to work as keynote speakers or commentators.

Participants are now invited to submit proposals that cover the following areas listed below. This list, however, is not closed and we encourage proposals that broaden it.

- Comparative philosophy**
- Chinese philosophy**
- Ancient philosophies**
- Colonial/post-colonial thought**
- The East/West bias in comparative research**
- Contemporary applications of philosophical traditions**
- Representation and under representation**



We ask that graduate students who are interested in contributing to have a paper prepared for the conference, and be ready to share an abstract (about 200-300 words) by **October 9**, and a final version (about 2000-3000 words) by **October 22**. Your submission should include the following information in this order: name, affiliation (and state/province or country of affiliation), and email address. Please send your abstract and conference paper to **philo20181109@126.com**. The acceptance of conference papers will be informed by email on **October 25**.

The conference will be held on ECNU's campus. We will provide the participants with room and board during the conference.

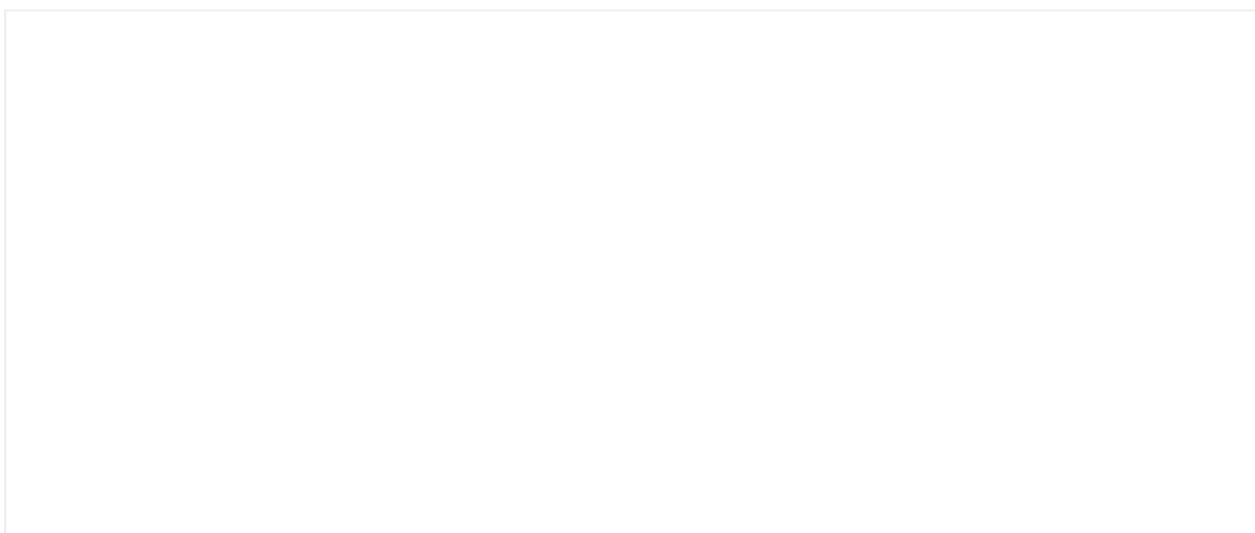

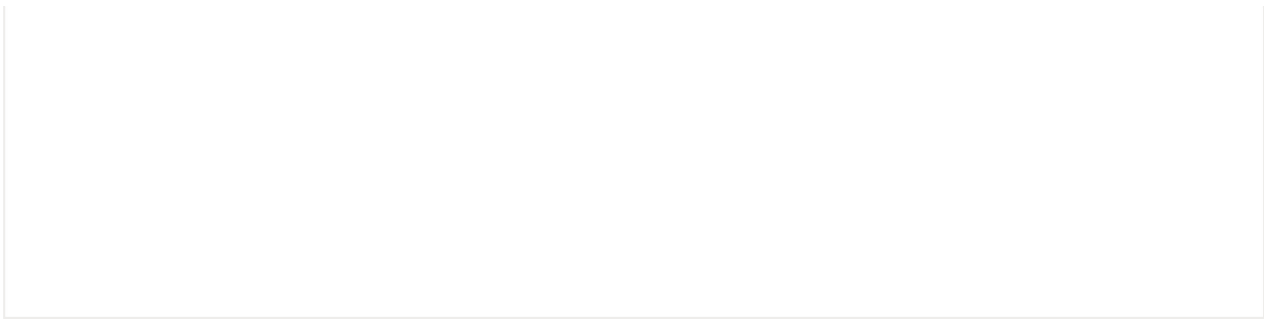
